

**Application for ENGL BC3996:  
Special Project in Theatre or Critical Interpretation  
(1 point)**

Senior English majors who are concentrating in theatre and who have completed three courses in theatre history/dramatic literature will normally take this Special Project in combination with an additional dramatic literature course. This combined special project counts in place of one senior seminar.

In rare cases, the English Department Chair may permit an English major not concentrating in theatre or writing to take ENGL BC3996 in combination with another course.
